Introduction

This Prospectus contains rules and regulations applicable for selection and admission to the B.Sc. Nursing and M.Sc. Nursing Courses, against sanctioned intake for the academic year 2026-27, in the college 15% NRI seats set apart for the dependents of Non Resident Indians for B.Sc. Nursing course.

This prospectus is subject to modification/addition/deletion as may be deemed necessary by the college and subject to the Judgments of Honorable Courts of law/ Approving Authority.





Admission

- **B.Sc. Nursing** (Residential program)
- **Number of seats and details of the reservation**



The College has been conducting B.Sc. Nursing Course with an intake of 100 seats. As usual, the College is willing for the seat sharing with the Hon'ble Govt. of Kerala i.e. 50 seats for Merit and Management Quotas respectively. Out of the above 100 seats, 15% seats will be filled up by the candidates from NRI quota 35% of the seats shall be filled up under the Management Quota. The remaining 50% seats are allotted by LBS under merit quota as per the consensual agreement with the Govt. of Kerala. The details of reservation of seats are as follows.

Eligibility for Admission

- Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education of Kerala or equivalent examinations recognized by any of the Universities in the State of Kerala with an Aggregate of minimum 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and 50% marks in English in the second year and who secured 50% marks in the entrance examination conducted by the college for Management Quota / LBS for Merit Quota.
- Admitted candidates will be subject to the rules & regulations of the competent authorities from time to time.

Relaxation of Marks

- Candidates belonging to SEBC (Socially and Educationally Backward Classes) in the State of Kerala with a total annual family income up to Rs. 6.00 lakhs will have a relaxation of 5% marks. The Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe Candidates in the State of Kerala need 45% marks in the qualifying examination.
- Those candidates claiming relaxation of marks shall produce necessary certificates from the authority concerned. There will be no reservation of seats for SEBC and or SC/ST candidates under the Management quota.
- Eligibility Certificates: Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from places other than State of Kerala shall produce the certificate of recognition and equivalency of qualifying examination from KUHS Thrissur. This should be furnished at the time of interview for admission.

Age

- Applicants should have completed 17 years of age on the 31st December 2026. No relaxation of the minimum age will be allowed. The maximum age limit for admission shall be 35 years. Self-attested copy of the relevant page of school record namely SSLC/ICSE/CBSE/ certificate
- Showing the date of birth/copy of the birth certificate should be produced at the time of admission.

- Application for admission to courses of B.Sc. Nursing and M.Sc. Nursing can be registered only online through a single application. The provision for applying online is available at the website www.pkdacollegeofnursing.com. The prospectus can also be downloaded from the website.
- However, it will not be available by post. "Submission of more than one application by a candidate will lead to rejection of the applications for the same course submitted subsequent to the first application".

Application Fee

- The application fee will be Rs.1000/- for all candidates, payable / Online by using Credit/Debit/Internet Banking / QR Code facility.
- Application submission will be completed only after successful payment of the Application fee through online.

Remittance of Application Fee and Submission of Application Form

- Candidate must submit a hard copy of Application along with certificates copies self attested.

Selection of Allotment Process

- The Allotment Process for Seats in P. K. Das College of Nursing for which will be made as per the schedule Included In the prospectus and allotments will be strictly based on merit by following the reservation criteria as mentioned in this prospectus.
- If sufficient candidates are not available in the list of applicants, the vacant seats will be filled up by the eligible candidates from the spot allotment.

Admission & Payment of Fees

- The selected candidates will be informed through a call / SMS To the registered mobile number provided in the application.
- The students shall pay all fees of the 1st year of the course at the time of admission which will not be refunded under any circumstances.

If any candidate discontinues the course, after the closing of admission as notified by the authority, the candidate has to pay the full fee of the remaining course. The Collection of liquidated damages shall be as per the final decision of the AFRC or Court of Law.
