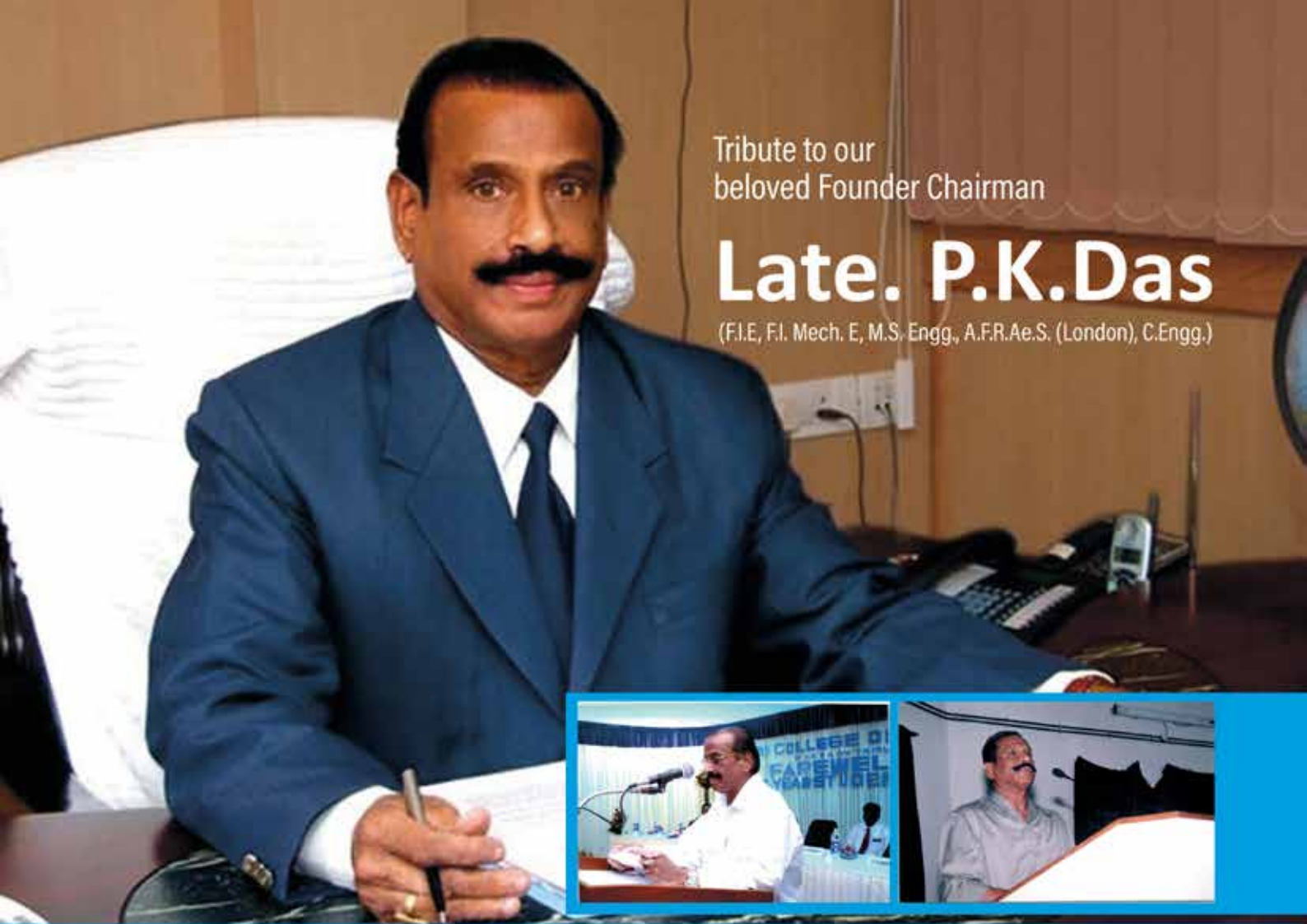

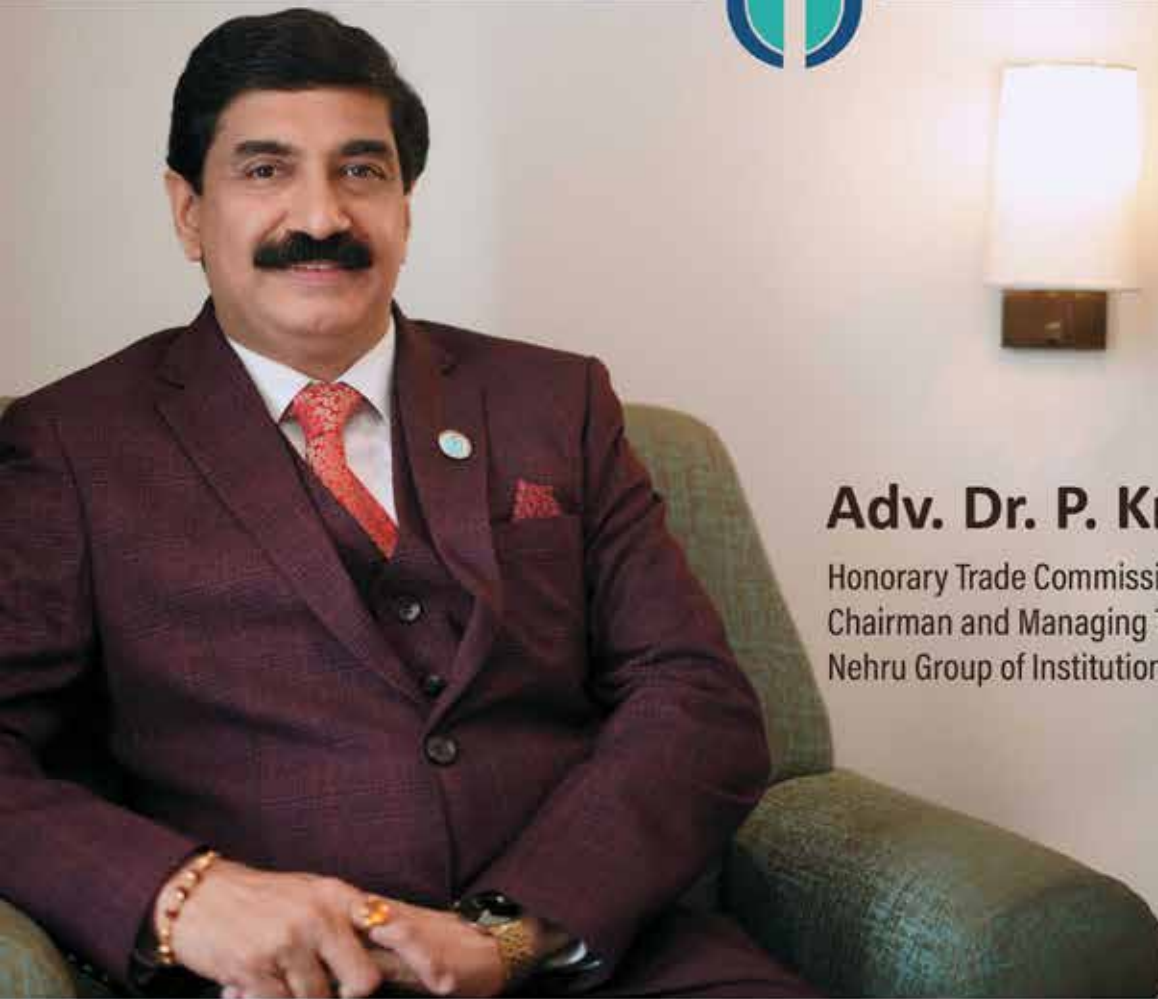

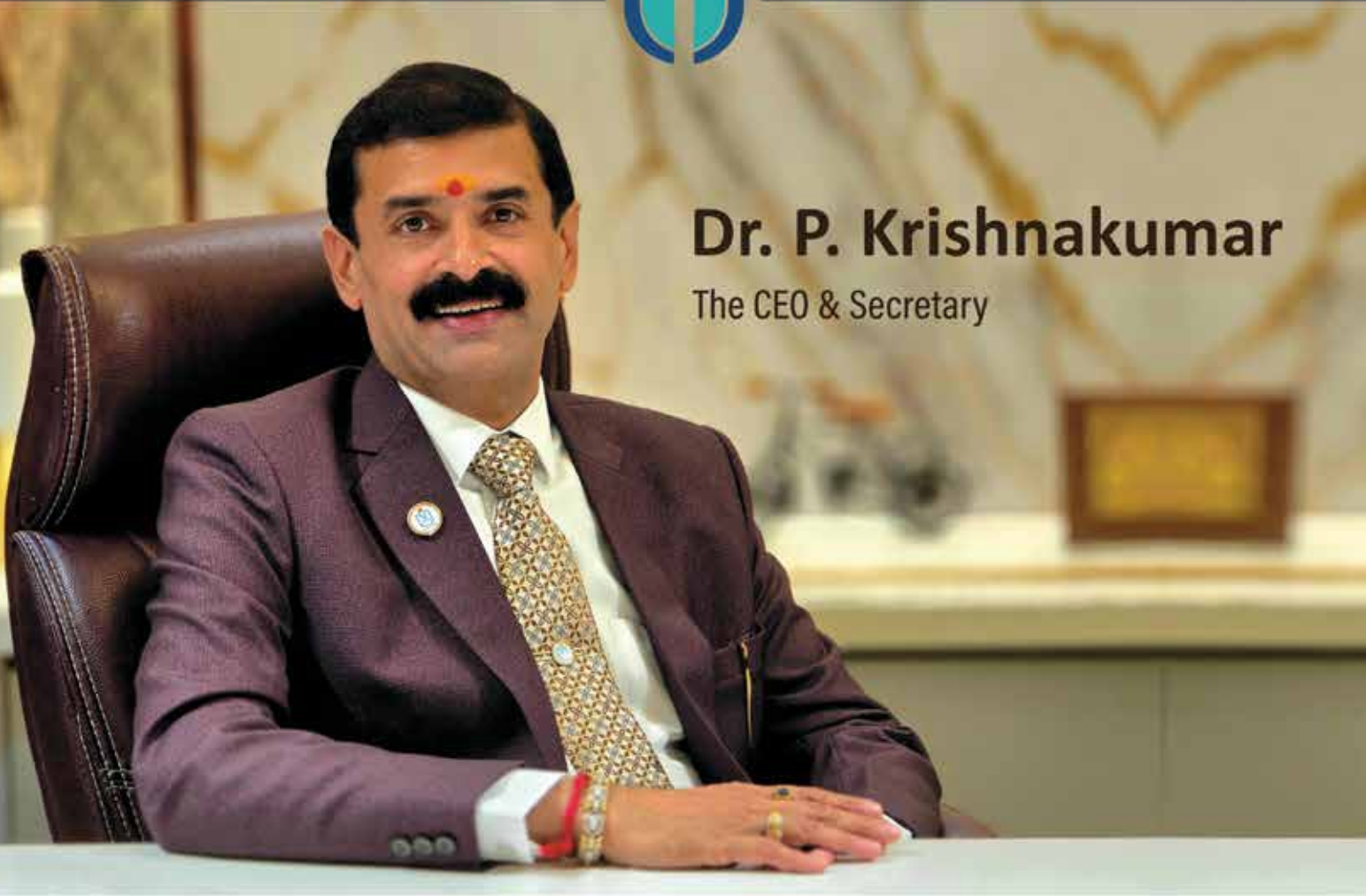

Introduction

This Prospectus contains rules and regulations applicable for selection and admission to the B.Sc. Nursing and M.Sc. Nursing Courses, against sanctioned intake for the academic year 2026-27, in the college 15% NRI seats set apart for the dependents of Non Resident Indians for B.Sc. Nursing course.

This prospectus is subject to modification/addition/deletion as may be deemed necessary by the college and subject to the Judgments of Honorable Courts of law/ Approving Authority.





Admission

- **B.Sc. Nursing** (Residential program)
- **Number of seats and details of the reservation**



The College has been conducting B.Sc. Nursing Course with an intake of 100 seats. As usual, the College is willing for the seat sharing with the Hon'ble Govt. of Kerala i.e. 50 seats for Merit and Management Quotas respectively. Out of the above 100 seats, 15% seats will be filled up by the candidates from NRI quota 35% of the seats shall be filled up under the Management Quota. The remaining 50% seats are allotted by LBS under merit quota as per the consensual agreement with the Govt. of Kerala. The details of reservation of seats are as follows.

Eligibility for Admission

- Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education of Kerala or equivalent examinations recognized by any of the Universities in the State of Kerala with an Aggregate of minimum 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and 50% marks in English in the second year and who secured 50% marks in the entrance examination conducted by the college for Management Quota / LBS for Merit Quota.
- Admitted candidates will be subject to the rules & regulations of the competent authorities from time to time.

Relaxation of Marks

- Candidates belonging to SEBC (Socially and Educationally Backward Classes) in the State of Kerala with a total annual family income up to Rs. 6.00 lakhs will have a relaxation of 5% marks. The Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe Candidates in the State of Kerala need 45% marks in the qualifying examination.
- Those candidates claiming relaxation of marks shall produce necessary certificates from the authority concerned. There will be no reservation of seats for SEBC and or SC/ST candidates under the Management quota.
- Eligibility Certificates: Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from places other than State of Kerala shall produce the certificate of recognition and equivalency of qualifying examination from KUHS Thrissur. This should be furnished at the time of interview for admission.

Age

- Applicants should have completed 17 years of age on the 31st December 2026. No relaxation of the minimum age will be allowed. The maximum age limit for admission shall be 35 years. Self-attested copy of the relevant page of school record namely SSLC/ICSE/CBSE/ certificate
- Showing the date of birth/copy of the birth certificate should be produced at the time of admission.



M.Sc. Nursing (Residential Program)

Number of seats and details of the reservation

The College has been conducting M.Sc. Nursing Course with an intake of 10 seats. Medical Surgical Nursing (Critical Care Nursing) 5 seats and Community Health Nursing 5 seats. P. K. Das College of Nursing is willing for the seat sharing with the Hon'ble Govt. of Kerala 5 seats for State Merit and Management Quota respectively. 50% of seats are filled by the management and the remaining 50% of seats are allotted by CEE under merit quota as per the consensual agreement with the Govt. of Kerala. The detail of the reservation of seats is as follows.

The number of seats and allocation of seats under various quotas may also change subject to conditions of any consensual agreement that may be signed between the Government of Kerala and the college.



Eligibility for Admission

- Candidates who have passed regular B.Sc. Nursing course with a minimum 55% aggregate of any University in Kerala or any other University recognized as equivalent to it by Kerala University of Health Sciences.
- B.Sc. Nursing candidates should have one year of experience/internship after Registration with the Nursing Council.
- Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing qualified shall have one year of experience prior to Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing and registration in the respective State Nursing Council.
- Candidates should have valid registration from Kerala Nurses & Midwives Council (KNMC). Those candidates who have registered with other State Councils should produce KNMC registration at the time of admission.
- Eligibility Certificates : Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from a University outside Kerala State shall produce the certificate of recognition and equivalency of the qualifying examination from KUHS Thrissur. This should be furnished at the time of the interview for admission.

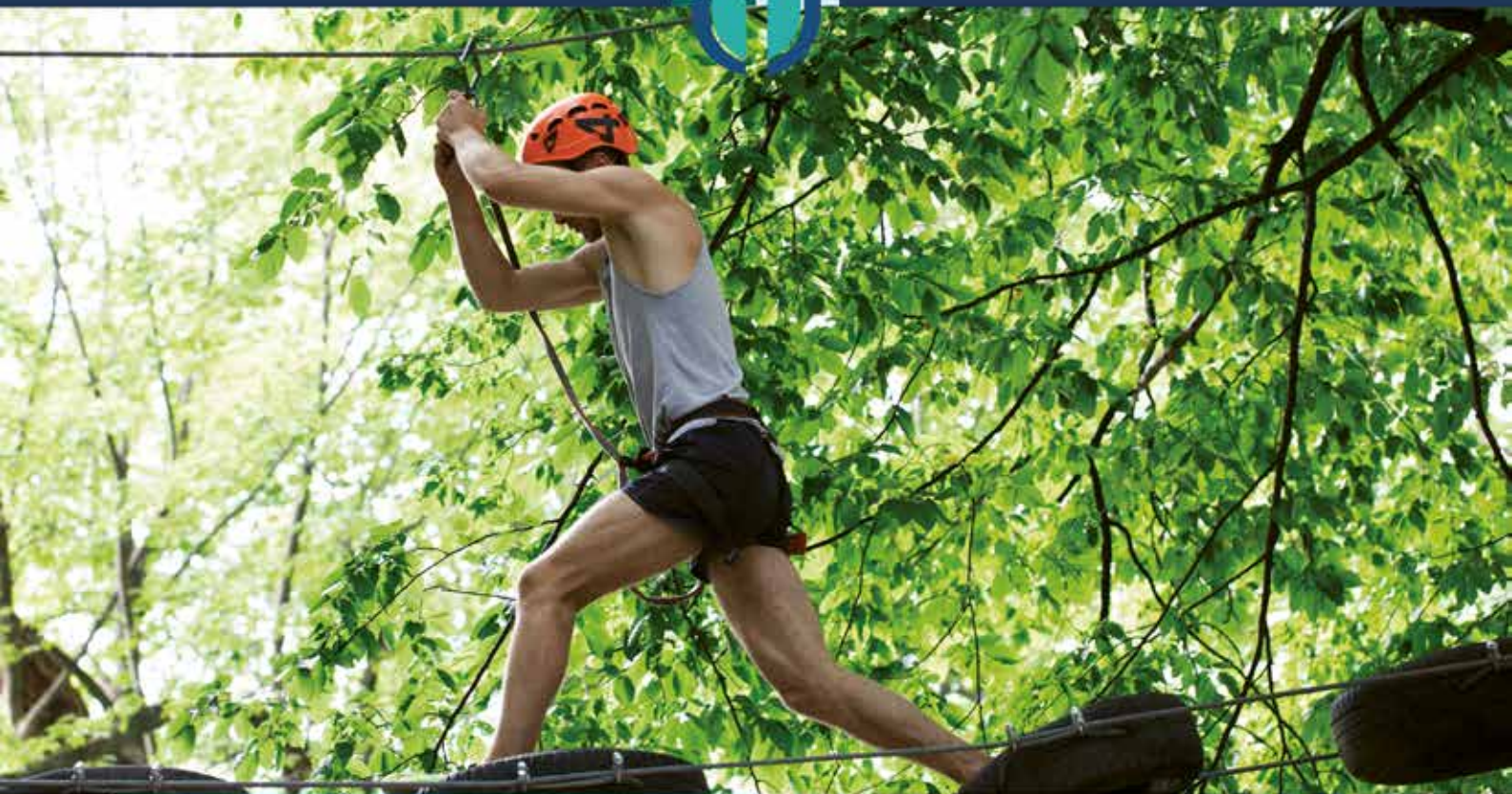

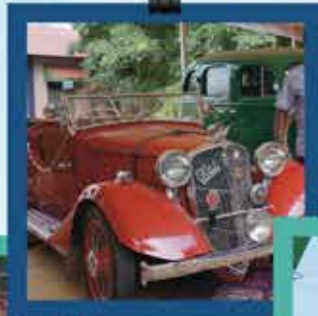

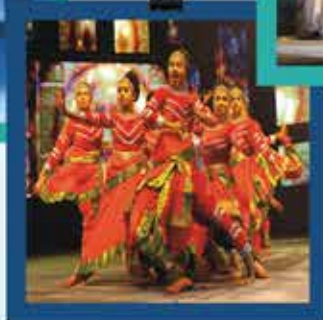

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

- Any student Admitted to B.Sc. / M.Sc. Nursing under Nehru Group of Institutions, Kerala shall undergo the prescribed course of study as per the stipulations of Kerala University of Health Sciences and directions of INC, KNMC.
- College working hours will be between 8.30 am and 4.30 pm on all working days.
- As far as possible the students must attend all classes throughout the course achieving 100% attendance.
- Attendance is marked for each subject. 80% attendance is mandatory for each subject for writing the university examinations. Under unavoidable circumstances students are permitted to take leave.
- Duty leave is applied only if the attendance is 65% and above and is normally sanctioned for any approved activity like sports, fests, conference or any other extra-curricular activities taken up by students outside the College. Duty leave can be applied only on the submission of concern certificate of participation. Leave is also permitted on medical grounds or on personal exigencies. 100% Clinical Attendance Is Mandatory To Apply For Provisional Certificate To The University, Hence Leave Taken During Clinical Posting Should Be Compensated. In case of long illness or major personal tragedies/contingencies the College Principal can relax the minimum attendance requirement to 80% to write the end semester examinations. This is permitted for one or more courses registered in the semester. Principal will keep all records, which lead to his/her decisions on attendance, for verification by the academic auditor. However this concession is applicable only to any 2 semesters during the entire programme. In case of prolonged illness, break of study is permitted. Other leave rules as per KUHS Ordinance.
- Students are required to follow proper procedure while availing leave. A leave requisition form duly signed by the parents/guardian has to be submitted to the Class Advisor/ HOD either before or immediately after availing leave. Medical certificate can be attached if leave is more than 3 days continuously.
- Students are required to attend classes wearing decent attire.
- Students are expected to take care of their personal property and the College Authority does not have any responsibility in respect of the loss of property of students in the College premises or hostel or for any accidental injury caused to the students during the course of study in this institution.
- All entries made in the application for admission ought to be correct and authentic and no material shall be concealed or misrepresented.
 - a) All fees pertaining to the college are to be paid on or before the prescribed date intimated in the prospectus or calendar and as per the undertaking provided.
 - b) For the late payment of fees, late fees may be levied.



- All original certificates are to be deposited with the College and the same will be forwarded to the University for Verification.
- For every payment which should be made to the College Office, a receipt in the proper form duly signed by the Accountant should be obtained.
- Every student will be issued an identity card on admission. This card is to be returned on completion of the course. In case of loss of the ID a DUPLICATE ID card will be issued.
- Any other lawful due to the College should be paid promptly when the College makes a request.
- Students are required to undertake Industrial visit and Internship as an integral part of the course and expense for the same should be borne by the students.
- Every student should get admitted to the course at the beginning of every academic year irrespective of the duration of the course. This is to be ensured by Principal that the deficiencies noted in the performance of the students in the preceding academic year are made good by proper counseling and other remedial measures by the College. Application will be supplied for the said readmissions at free of cost. If deficiencies are not removed totally, the student may be given conditional admission with proper undertaking by the student jointly with the parent. When readmitted to the higher class a readmission card will be issued to the student by the Principal. In case of readmission for year out / under break of study student should apply for readmission to the University through Principal. Further on confirmation of readmission the student shall pay the requisite tuition fees to the college and readmission slip to be obtained from the Academic Office.
- Those students who have not sought admission nor paid the fees for the next academic year shall cease to have their names in rolls of the college and they shall not be permitted to attend the classes without complying these formalities. Parents and students are requested to cooperate with the college authorities in this regard.
- First year students are advised to stay in college hostel or must come from their respective home. No students are allowed to stay outside.
 - a) List of working days and holidays given in the KUHS academic calendar are applicable to the students.
 - b) Students can download all forms related to academic and non-academic from the respective college.
- Websites for their usage (Eg:-TC Request Form, Migration Certificate, Leave Application, Hostel Admission and Relieving form, Caution deposit refund form, Dues clearance form, Bus pass form etc.)
- Students should follow the traffic rules strictly inside the Campus and vehicles should park only in the designated parking area. Entry beyond that point is strictly prohibited.
- Bike race / motor car race / procession or similar activities should not be permitted inside the Campus/Hostels.
- No vehicles should be used during celebrations Inside the College Campus and Hostels.
- In the interest of security of students, Police may be informed in advance about all festival celebrations.



REGULATIONS OF DRESS

- Proper dress code (Uniform of the College) should be adhered to before entering the Classrooms, Laboratories or Clinicals on all working days.
- All students have to wear Identity Card In the college premises in proper manner. The same should be produced when and where required in the campus. ID card is mandatory for all academics and non-academic matters.
- Male students should come with proper uniform and insert their shirts and wear black leather shoes while coming to the College. Nobody should come with exotic hairstyles.
- Female students should wear college uniform regularly with black shoes.
- Casual dresses, T-Shirts. Jeans and Dhotis are not permitted during academic sessions/working hours.
- The Principal/ HODs and all Faculty Members are empowered to check the dress code of students.

REGULATIONS ON CONDUCT

- Students should not get involved in any nefarious activities that will be degrading the College, State or Nation.
- Students should not indulge in bullying, eve-teasing or Ragging any other person. If they violate this rule, suitable action shall be initiated against them according to the relevant Indian Law.
- Students should not smoke or use narcotics, drugs, tobacco, alcohol, any intoxicating or addictive substance or any substance injurious to health within the College campus and hostel. If violated, serious action including Criminal proceedings shall be initiated against them.
- Students should not wander in the verandas or Corridors and create disturbance to the class in progress during class hours. Nor should they go out of the class unless called for by the College Authorities for some valid reason.
- Any kind of misbehavior shall be viewed seriously.
- Students shall not defile or desecrate the rooms, walls, floor, furniture and other equipment etc in the College Campus and hostel, Any violation will attract suitable action, and steps shall be taken to procure the cost of repair/restoration from the student.
- Students are expected to be polite in language and behavior. Misbehavior to girl students, use of threat or violence against members of the staff or fellow students will be considered as a very serious case of misconduct.
- A student suspended twice and gets Involved in misbehavior for the third time shall be summarily dismissed from the College.
- Students are to refrain from using profanity or vulgarity.



- Visitors/parents/guardians are not permitted to see the students during class hours. However under extra ordinary circumstances College Authorities may waive this clause.
- Students must get permission before entering the staff room or office.
- Students are responsible for the safe custody of tools/equipment /apparatus, etc they use. In case of any damage, either willful or accidental, steps shall be taken to procure the cost of repair or In case of irreparable circumstances the cost of new equipment, from the student.
- Political, union activities, dharnas, gharao and shouting slogans or mass boycotting from the classes are totally forbidden. Any violation will attract strict action. Admission is granted to the College under this specific condition alone, which parents may be noted. Admission to the higher class is also governed by this specific condition. These type of activities are totally banned in the college campus and hostel by various court of law as per various Judgments.
- Use of Mobile phones is banned inside the Class room/ laboratory/Clinical Area and library. If somebody brings the mobile phone, it should be kept in separate place provided by the college. Carrying Mobile phones to examination halls is a strictly prohibited and punishable crime.
- Those students who go out of the Campus during class hours need to obtain permission slip from their respective HOD's/authorized person.

ACADEMIC REGULATIONS

- All students are put under the guidance of a Faculty Member for advice, help and monitoring the progress in their studies, well being and to solve their personal problems.
- The Faculty Advisor shall keep the Head of the Institution Informed about the progress of students in their academic performance, behavior, etc. The Faculty Advisor must maintain a record of the same.
- Parents must meet the Faculty Advisor/Principal at least once in a semester and get a feedback about their ward.
- Students must be regular in attending series test and assignments.





LIBRARY REGULATIONS

- Library will be kept open during the college working hours and Saturdays.
- Each student is permitted to borrow 2 books at a time for a period of 15 days.
- Students may take the book twice consecutively and after that it shall not be issued to the same student.
- Each Student is Permitted may keep the book for 14 days and should return the same. If not returned in time the Librarian shall fix an appropriate fine per day of default.
- Strict silence is to be observed in the library.
- Any misbehaviour in the library and any act of defiling books shall attract strict action. Steps shall be taken to procure the cost of repair/ restoration/replacement from the student.
- Photocopy facilities are available and may be utilized by the students. For this the cost must be borne by the student.
- Students shall leave the books on the table after reading and they are not expected to replace the books on the racks. Reference books and journals will not be issued to anybody.
- Each student is expected to handle the books in careful manner.
- While entering the library, member should leave their personal belongings in the shelf provided. They are allowed to take only loose sheets of writing papers with them.
- Member should see that the books they borrow are in good condition. If any books is found changed on returning, the concerned member is able to rectify/ compensate for the damage as decided by the librarian.
- Members can reserve books by giving advance intimation to the librarian through the intent register. Member should return the borrowed books on or before the due date. No reminder will be sent regarding the return of books. If a member fails to return the books in time he / she will have to pay fine of Rs2 per day per book. Ten days after the due date the fine will be increased to Rs. 10 per day per book till the book is returned or replaced.
- If any student loses a book, he/ she should bear the cost for the replacement of the book. In case the particular book is out of print, an alternative book of approximately the same cost shall be selected by the Principal and the cost shall be borne by the student.
- Reference books are exclusively for reference purpose only within the library and will not be Issued outside or no photo copying is allowed.
- Library identity card is mandatory for library transaction.
- Any member violating the library rules and regulations will forfeit their privilege to utilize the library facilities forever.



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
